PUBLISHING ETHICS GUIDELINES PUBLISHING ETHICS AND MISCONDUCT

Journal of Legal Studies and Researches is committed to upholding the highest standards of publishing ethics and integrity. *Journal of Legal Studies and Researches* adheres to the core principles of transparency, honesty, and fairness in scholarly publishing. Authors, reviewers, and editors are expected to abide by these guidelines to maintain the integrity of the publication process.

Duties and Responsibilities of Author

Originality and Plagiarism: Authors must ensure that their work is original and properly attributed to the original sources when using the work or ideas of others. Plagiarism in any form, including self-plagiarism, is strictly prohibited.

Data and Results: Authors should accurately present their research findings and provide sufficient details to allow others to replicate their work, when applicable. Fabrication, falsification, or manipulation of data and results is unethical and unacceptable.

Authorship: All individuals who have made substantial contributions to the research should be listed as co-authors. Proper acknowledgment should be given to individuals who have contributed in a meaningful way but do not meet the criteria for authorship.

Multiple Submissions and Redundant Publications: Authors should not submit the same manuscript to multiple journals simultaneously or publish redundant publications. Authors must disclose any related publications or manuscripts under consideration during the submission process.

Conflict of Interest: Authors should disclose any financial or personal relationships that may influence the research or its interpretation. Any potential conflicts of interest must be acknowledged in the manuscript.

Duties and Responsibilities of Reviewers
